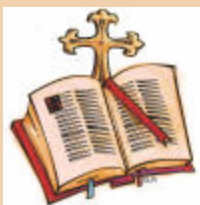

UPDATED COVID-19 GUIDELINES

As of Pentecost Sunday, the Dispensation from the Obligation to attend Mass expires and there will be **100% capacity (no need for social distancing)**. Although pew barriers, tapes, and signs for traffic flow will be removed, masks will **remain required for those unvaccinated** while in the church. There are no restrictions on the use of readers as well.

The exchange of the sign of peace will continue as we have been doing it — safely, and from a distance.

The offertory procession and altar servers are now permitted.

The distribution of Communion will return to its place within the Mass; after Communion, we will conclude the Mass as we used to. We will again have two Communion lines, but only the priests will be distributing Communion at this time.

Even though the distancing requirements are relaxed, masks are still required for all attending Mass in the church. When receiving Communion, please keep your mask on, right up until you receive the Eucharist in the hand; lower your mask and **immediately** consume the host, then replace your mask and return to your seat.
