

# **Weekday Masses to Resume!**

In coordination with the Archdiocese of Hartford, the Diocese of Norwich announces the churches of our diocese may resume the public celebration of weekday Masses ONLY beginning Monday, June 8, 2020. (See Mass schedule at left.) <=

The Most Reverend Michael R. Cote, Bishop of Norwich, released the Parish Reopening Guidelines to the Pastors of the Diocese. The primary goal in issuing these standards is to provide necessary guidance rooted both in sound liturgical principles as well as to keep everyone, faithful and clergy, as safe as reasonably possible given the requirements of the present circumstances.

The celebration of public Masses on Saturday evening and Sunday continues to be suspended until further notice. Please note: limitation on gatherings for religious worship of 100 people or 25% capacity indoors or 150 people outdoors established by CT Governor Ned Lamont's Executive Orders remain in effect.

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Today we celebrate the Trinity, the Divine dance, a perfectly choreographed interplay of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Trinity is mirrored in Holy Matrimony: the husband love his wife, the wife loves her husband. Their love is so powerful that nine months later their love is given a new name: their child is a new person. Similarly, the Father loves the Son, the Son loves the Father. Their love is so great, it is the Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Holy Trinity!

Together they dance and move as one, though three unique Persons with distinctive, yet harmonious, patterns and steps. They provide a mirror into our soul. Within each one of us, the Divine dance continues, and the music of God's love continues to inspire, sustain, and recreate us with every step and melody. Can you hear the music that the Triune God is playing? Where is the dance leading you? Our minds can never truly understand or know God. But our hearts can seek and find Him. From beginning to end, God is one and, at the same time, three in one: Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier. God's holy Trinitarian dance is calling you to holiness. Join in and dance!

# Miracle Approved! Father McGivney to be Beatified!



The Vatican announced on May 27th,
that Pope Francis approved the
promulgation of a decree recognizing a
miracle attributed to the intercession of
the founder of the Knights of Columbus, Venerable
Father Michael J. McGivney, a Connecticut priest and
founder of The Knights of Columbus.

Born of Irish immigrant parents in 1852 in Waterbury, Connecticut, Father McGivney was a central figure in the dramatic growth of the Church in the United States in the late 19th century. Ordained in Baltimore in 1877, he ministered to a heavily Irish-American and immigrant community in the then-Diocese of Hartford. At a time of anti-Catholic sentiment, he worked tirelessly to keep his flock close to the faith in part by finding practical solutions to their many problems – spiritual and temporal alike. With a group of the leading Catholic men of New Haven, he founded the Knights of Columbus in 1882 at St. Mary's Church to provide spiritual support for Catholic men and financial resources for families that had suffered the loss of their breadwinner.

The fledgling group soon became a major force in the areas of evangelization, charity, racial integration, and the defense of religious freedom.

Father McGivney spent his entire priesthood in parish ministry and died of pneumonia on August 14, 1890—two days after his 38th birthday – after falling ill amid a pandemic. Recent scientific evidence indicates that that pandemic – like the current one – may have been caused by a coronavirus.

Known by his contemporaries for his devotion to the faith and his embodiment of the characteristics of the "Good Samaritan," his cause for sainthood was opened in the Archdiocese of Hartford in 1997. St. John Paul II – who was pope at that time – lauded Father McGivney's principles, stating in 2003, "In fidelity to the vision of Father McGivney, may you continue to seek new ways of being a leaven of the Gospel in the world and a spiritual force for the renewal of the Church in holiness, unity and truth." In March 2008, he was declared a Venerable Servant of God by Pope Benedict XVI, who during his visit to St. Patrick's Cathedral cited the "remarkable accomplishment of that exemplary American priest, the Venerable Michael McGivney, whose vision and zeal led to the establishment of the Knights of Columbus."

## **Finance Council News**

The Parish "bread and butter" income (Weekly Offertory) is only down 3.13%. This is absolutely **AWESOME** and a proven indicator of the generosity and dedication CTK's parishioners have to their church. *THANK YOU!* 

The Parish applied for a "PPP" loan and was approved for the amount of \$45,617. If you are not familiar with this, PPP is a program developed under the CARES ACT which includes financing options for small businesses owners and independent contractors, who continue paying employees even though their work places are shut down due to the pandemic. Charitable organizations also qualified for these loans. Current guidelines for repayment would indicate that CTK will not be required to pay back the loan as long as the funds were used for Payroll as well as other specific recurring expenses. If for any reason the parish did need to repay the loan, it would need to be paid back over a 2 year period at the rate of 1.0% CTK's PPP (administered through the SBA) loan was obtained through Webster Bank. We are keeping in contact with Webster Bank & they will forward the "forgiveness" application as soon as it is available. - John Smith, Finance Council Chair
