

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Jesus knows that the challenges a disciple of the Gospel will face in the world are real. He tells all of us point blank, "Do not be afraid." There are many things we can fear as we attempt to live the Gospel: unpopularity, being rebuked, rejection, anger, being challenged, having to defend ourselves, standing alone, insecurity, failure, and even death. Many folks know that their faith calls them to live life more deliberately and radically but are cowards when it comes to putting it into practice. We easily justify sticking with the "acceptable" norms with which we are accustomed. These only serve to keep us stuck and mired in mediocrity. The Gospel — given flesh by the very presence of Christ — seeks to stretch, challenge, and change us. We do not have to fear anything, even death. Sometimes, living with our fears brings us a sadly disordered sense of comfort. Maybe what we really fear above all else is change.

COME TO MASS! Public Weekday Masses Resume! NEW time: 8AM, M-F

In coordination with the Archdiocese of Hartford, the Diocese of Norwich announces the churches of our diocese may resume the public celebration of ONLY weekday Masses on June 8, 2020. (See Mass schedule at left.) <=

The celebration of public Masses on Saturday evening and Sunday continues to be <u>suspended until</u>

<u>further notice</u>. Please note: limitation on gatherings for religious worship of 100 people or 25% capacity indoors or 150 people outdoors as commanded by CT Governor Ned Lamont's Executive Orders, remain in effect for all churches. We are complying with orders by limiting attendance, social distancing, many pews are taped off and unused, masks are to be worn, hand sanitizer at entrance, no singing nor processing, and Communion after mass.

The Most Reverend Michael R. Cote, Bishop of Norwich, dispensed of the Sunday Mass obligation and released the Parish Reopening Guidelines to the Pastors of the Diocese. The primary goal in issuing these standards is to provide necessary guidance rooted both in sound liturgical principles as well as to keep everyone, faithful and clergy, as safe as reasonably possible given the requirements of the present circumstances.

Will You Say Yes?

You find yourself in the difficult situation of being accused of blasphemy and confronting possible execution. Your crime is believing in Jesus Christ. The question is then asked of you, "Are you a Christian, a follower of the one named Jesus Christ?" Your answer may very well dictate what happens to you next. What is your answer?

It is probably easier to answer this question when the scenario is make-believe. All of us want to believe that we would say yes to the question of belief in Jesus, but strange things happen when humans panic in the face of extreme stress. As we reflect on what we would say, there are those all over the world who are being asked that very same question. It is a question that was asked of many in the first centuries of the Church. Those who respond "yes" are considered martyrs and saints.

We might not usually think of all this in terms of good stewardship living. However, our faith is also a gift we have received from God to cultivate, grow, and share with others. The more interesting question than the one posed above is, "Would an accuser even think of asking you such a question?" Would you have cultivated, grown, and shared your faith enough that anyone would even consider you worthy of asking the question? They might assume you don't know Jesus Christ at all. I don't like conflict and do not seek out conflict, but I would rather someone ask the first question posed than assume there is no reason to confront me in the first place. -Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS



Finance Council News

The Parish "bread and butter" income (Weekly Offertory) is only down 3.13%. This is absolutely **AWESOME** and a proven indicator of the generosity and dedication CTK's parishioners have to their church. *THANK YOU!*

The Parish applied for a "PPP" loan and was approved for the amount of \$45,617. If you are not familiar with this, PPP is a program developed under the CARES ACT which includes financing options for small businesses owners and independent contractors, who continue paying employees even though their work places are shut down due to the pandemic. Charitable organizations also qualified for these loans. Current guidelines for repayment would indicate that CTK will not be required to pay back the loan as long as the funds were used for Payroll as well as other specific recurring expenses. If for any reason the parish did need to repay the loan, it would need to be paid back over a 2 year period at the rate of 1.0% CTK's PPP (administered through the SBA) loan was obtained through Webster Bank. We are keeping in contact with Webster Bank & they will forward the "forgiveness" application as soon as it is available. - John Smith, Finance Council Chair
